Happiness is being humble.

Blessed are those who mourn, for they shall be comforted.

Matthew 5:4

Happiness comes from mourning.



Matt. 7:13-14

Blessed are the gentle, for they shall inherit the earth.

Matthew 5:5

Happiness is being in control of self.

Blessed are those who hunger and thirst for righteousness, for they shall be satisfied.

Matthew 5:7

Happiness is serving others.

Blessed are the pure in heart, for they shall see God. Matthew 5:8

Happiness is giving God all your heart.



Matt. 7:13-14

Blessed are the peacemakers, for they shall be called sons of God.

Matthew 5:9

Happiness is making peace with others.

Blessed are those who have been persecuted for the sake of righteousness, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven.

Matthew 5:10

Matt. 7:13-14

Blessed are you when men revile you, and persecute you, and say all kinds of evil against you falsely, on account of Me.

Matthew 5:11

Happiness is suffering for what's right.



Matt. 7:13-14

Rejoice and be glad, for your reward in heaven is great, for so they persecuted the prophets who were before you.
