What is gambling (gaming)?

To play at any game of chance for stakes. Involves wagering or betting. In gambling one stands to gain at and by the loss of others. The deciding factor as to who will gain or loose is determined by an event that is arbitrarily selected or contrived by those participating in the gambling.

Gambling is an unrighteous way of getting gain.

Three laws of rightly getting gain:

- 1. Law of labor wages received for work
- 2. Law of exchange commodity purchased with money or goods
- 3. Law of love money or goods received as a gift

There is no specific command in the word of God that says "You shall not gamble"

A greedy desire to have more. Desiring something that belongs to someone else without regard to right or wrong.

For from within, out of the heart of men, proceed the evil thoughts, fornications, thefts, murders, adulteries, deeds of coveting and wickedness, as well as deceit, sensuality, envy, slander, pride and foolishness.

Then he said, 'This is what I will do: I will tear down my barns and build larger ones, and there I will store all my grain and my goods. And I will say to my soul, "Soul, you have many goods laid up for many years to come; take your ease, eat, drink and be merry."

"Teacher, which is the great commandment in the Law?" And He said to him, " 'YOU SHALL LOVE THE LORD YOUR GOD WITH ALL YOUR HEART, AND WITH ALL YOUR SOUL, AND WITH ALL YOUR MIND.' This is the great and foremost commandment. The second is like it, 'YOU SHALL LOVE YOUR NEIGHBOR AS YOURSELF.'

What is wrong with gambling?

Gambling is the opposite of loving our neighbor

Romans 13:8-10

Owe nothing to anyone except to love one another; for he who loves his neighbor has fulfilled the law. For this, "YOU SHALL NOT COMMIT ADULTERY, YOU SHALL NOT MURDER, YOU SHALL NOT STEAL, YOU SHALL NOT COVET," and if there is any other commandment, it is summed up in this saying, "YOU SHALL LOVE YOUR NEIGHBOR AS YOURSELF." Love does no wrong to a neighbor; therefore love is the fulfillment of the law.

\$600 billion is wagered legally in the United States every year.

In inner-city areas, gambling is seen as a "ticket out of poverty".

When state lotteries are proposed the public is assured that enormous funds will be generated for education, despite studies showing that after states legalize lotteries they actually reduce spending for education.
